



## **Pace of Play Policy – 2022**

### **Summary Note**

The Pace of Play policy document is attached and the key summary points of note are;

- 1) The PP Policy covers general and competition play. Included are the Men competitions held on a Wednesday\ Saturday and the Ladies Tuesday competitions played through the summer season.
- 2) The Men competitions will be played predominantly off the white tees and in a 4 ball format whilst the ladies competitions are generally played in a 3 ball format. Players are reminded to cancel at least 24 hours before their scheduled tee time to allow other players the opportunity to book\enter the competition.
- 3) The average 4 ball should complete their round within a 4 hour period +\ - 15 minutes. Times will vary depending on weather conditions, severity of course set-up, competition type and handicap mix within a group.
- 4) Pace of Play markers are situated on the course near the 5,10 and 15<sup>th</sup> greens but these are for 3 ball competitions off the white tees and should be used as guidelines only. The average round time is 3 hours 35 minutes.
- 5) Round times will be monitored at periods throughout the season.
- 6) Any identified group exceeding the average time by 30 minutes or more will be contacted and asked to explain reason for slow play.
- 7) Slow play incidents during general play should be reported via the office with appropriate actions taken as necessary. Incidents during competition play will be handled by the Men\Ladies competition committees.
- 8) To minimise slow play, it is recommended all players should adopt "Ready Golf" provided it is safe and sensible to do so.
